In the weekly sessions with a classroom environment, we see a spiral approach to learning. The children may visit the same subject each year, but with a more nuanced understanding as they grow in ability and develop in their thinking process. This is why it is beneficial for your children to have uninterrupted religious education, they will develop a more mature faith when they have the tools to do so.

FFC classes are taught by volunteers; IU students, parents, and parishioners. The curriculum comes from two publishers: RCL Benzinger and Pflaum Gospel Weeklies, both are approved by the Archdiocese of Indianapolis for use in the parish. This is in conformity with the scope and sequence put forth by the Office of Catholic Education in the Archdiocese of Indianapolis.
